Both sets of bleachers and the picnic table were sanded. Rex Shaw and Rodney Bolich donated linseed oil and stain to apply. It was too windy to do so on clean up day so Rex and Sandy Shaw returned on a calmer day and completed that project. We may consider applying a second coat if needed.

The picnic table had a broken board. Rodney & Janet Bolich acquired a new board and Rodney Schmitt replaced.

A HUGE thanks to Russ Martin for running the forklift. We were able to place concrete pads underneath our memorial sign, lifting it out of the dirt and leveling it. Sandy Shaw and Kevin Duchow completed painting touch-ups to the memorial on the second work day.

Delbert worked hard watering the track so we could play with the sleds. He brought it to the club's attention that the pump on the water tank was broken beyond repairing. He then worked to find a replacement pump for a good deal from Dale Canterbury. He and Kevin Duchow got the new pump mounted on the water tank and it should be good to go.

Sled Update!

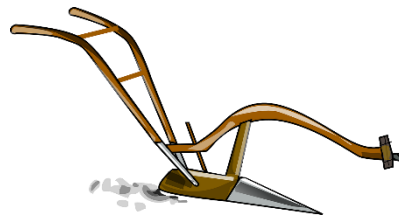
